Where We Are Moving Towards

The Langley Anchor is a community-based drop-in hub supporting youth experiencing instability. It offers a safe, low-barrier space where youth can pause, regulate, and access resources before challenges turn into full-blown crises. Focused on upstream prevention, the Anchor bridges the gap between active mobile outreach and long-term provincial services.
