WHERE WE ARE MOVING TOWARDS

Imagine being 15... It's late. Conflict at home has peaked. You don't feel safe, but you don't know where to go. So you leave. This moment changes everything. The Langley Anchor exists to change that moment—providing a place to land, breathe, and be supported before things escalate.

Coming Up

Running September through December, our pilot focuses on immediate stabilization. We are implementing **weekly "Safe Landing" hours** where youth can access regulation support without an appointment.

Phase 1 focuses on building the foundational connection between referral partners and direct youth engagement.

The Legacy Blueprint

Every youth in the pilot receives a "Legacy Blueprint"—a personalized toolkit for emotional regulation and conflict resolution. This isn't just a manual — it's a living tool for their future.

Tools include: Nervous system regulation techniques, safe-person identification, and crisis-interruption scripts.

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Be Part of the build. Because no youth should face their hardest moment alone

This isn't just a program; it's the first step toward a permanent 24/7 support centre in Langley. *We are building this with the community - not for it.*

We are currently:

- Building Strategic Partnerships

- Preparing for our Fall Pilot

Our work focuses on interrupting reactive patterns. Small situations don't have to become crises if there is a place to land.
